Saturday 13th Sep, the day of the Anniversary Tri-hash-alon, finally dawned. It all started in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia in 1938. Today there are more than 1,800 hashes with at least one to be found in every country around the world.

Mother Hash in KL asks that hares remember that, wherever possible, hounds much prefer running cross-country trails. In cities, like Geneva, it may be inevitable to have to set trails through some traffic, along urban streets and pavements. Especially during the dark winter months. At least try to include a park, reserve or residential traffic-free area.

Even though HHH has been dubbed « *the drinking club with a running problem* » we should remember the basic philosophy of our founders and the objectives which are:

1. To promote physical fitness amongst its members.
2. To get rid of weekend hangovers.
3. To acquire a good thirst and satisfy it in beer.
4. To persuade the older members that they are not as old as they feel.

Many packs break out the barbecue afterwards and make a party out of the occasion. Having formed a « *circle* » and armed with plenty of spare drinking vessels—or *plastic cups*—mismanagement introduce beer « *down-downs* » for the hares, visitors, leavers, returnees, new boots and other trail-related excuses. The RA, whose only responsibility is the *weather*, automatically gets a down-down if it rains!

Although it does still occasionally happen.

Hounds enjoy talking and comparing notes fraternising around the keg (now cans or bottles) of

beer after chasing the hares at yet another fun run.

If you are new in town, there is no better way to discover the non-touristy parts than running through them. You will also find your peers are able to point you in many right directions. This saves you having to make the same mistakes unnecessarily.

The emphasis is on spontaneity and good humour. Entertainment in the circle is often quite hilarious. No two chapters, or kennels, do it alike.

Historical correctness

Leman Geneva Hash House Harriers established its presence in this region on 11 September 1933 with its inauguration run in Divonne, France. Organized by Iron Lady, an active member of Royal Milan and Bordighera HHH, 34 virgins made history: representing Milan 19; Pays de Gex 7; Geneva 4; Zurich 2, Bern 2. On 17 Feb'95 Forrest Dump announced hashing on Monday at 1900. By the end of 1996 hashing in the Lemman Region had become so popular that active LGH3 harriettes Bawdy Tail, Idle Vice and Sunshine announced the creation of a second Geneva hash. The inaugural run, held on 11 Jan'97, established the practice of trails each Wednesday evening.

Thanks to our Trail Master, PegLeg, LGH3 has a World Wide Web home page. It provides all sorts of useful information such as upcoming events, links to other hash home pages and a list of mismanagement contacts.

Announcement extracted from issue 4 of LGH3's trash.

Geneva hashing Rule #1 The Bone of Contention

This bone was presumed to be that of a lost/missing hasher last seen heading towards the Pirhana-infested Versoix river in Geneva. Lovingly brought back to the circle by Idle Vice, during a CHF3 run, the bone lazed about for a while in the trunks of cars.

The religious advisers of LGH3 and CHFH3, Captain Sensible and Captain Sensible, got together and unanimously decided to dedicate the bone to lost hashers. Furthermore, the bone is to belong jointly to both Geneva hashes, being passed back and forth between packs. In the circle after the run; the hasher who has run

with the bone should pass it on. If no lost hasher could be found, the hasher in whose care it is should pass it on to a late or stupid hasher. The hasher awarded the bone must run with it UNTIL he/she/it is able to pass it on to the next candidate

IN THE OTHER hash. CS
